This Week in Class

In ELA students studied continued studying math vocabulary words and suffixes. Students are working on a biography book report, as well as completing text based responses in their reader's notebooks. We are encouraging parents to build on their child's reading stamina, please encourage your child to read at least 30 minutes a day.

We are into the 3rd quarter already, Wow!

Second quarter report cards are in your child's Friday Folder.

In Math we continued multiplication and division. We are continuing the multiplication facts of seven through twelve next week ($7 \times 0 = 0$, $7 \times 1 = 7$, $7 \times 3 = 21$) and so on).

Families continue to review analog time, counting and identifying coins, as well as making change with your child to help them learn the necessary skills needed

to succeed mathematically.

This week we began a unit on Geometry. Students are learning about 2 and 3 dimensional shapes, lines, line segments, and rays, as well as congruent and similar figures. There are real world examples of 3 dimensional figures all around us. Ask your child to point them out.

Science & Social Studies

In Science we will begin measuring capacity, using gallons, quarts, pints, and cups.

In Social Studies we will continue learning about America's early communities, the first settlers.
