Treasurer's Report

Beginning Balance: \$16,799.92

Deposits: \$11,778.50

Withdrawals: \$9,966.24

Ending Balance: \$18,612.18 (Principal's Fund of \$1,035.03 is included in this amount)

The bank statement and the check book had a difference of \$75.00. We were supposed to be reimbursed this amount in bank fees, but it appears that we have not been.

Deana requested funds for a notebook. Rhonda Ashley motioned and Denise Lang seconded. The motion carried.

New Business:

Buy One Get One Book Fair. Amy Rollo sent information on the book fair. Teacher preview will be after school on the 16th of May. The student dates are the 17th and 18th with a family time from 6:00-8:00 on the 17th. She presented ideas for One for Books and Read for The World Record. It was decided not to do One for Books. Read for The World Record was agreed upon since Amy Rollo agrees to handle this. It was noted that information needed to be clear on this for parents though.

Colonial Garden: Mr. Batdorf delivered checks totaling \$242.22 from The Can Man and Barnes and Nobles to go into the Colonial Garden Fund.

Living History Night: Mr. Batdorf presented a receipt totaling \$41.56 for cake to be paid from the principal's account.

5th Grade Fieldtrip: Mr. Batdorf presented an idea for a culminating field trip in fifth grade, related to history, such as Gettysburg or The Statue of Liberty to happen in subsequent years. There was discussion about this needing to be a school event that we may be able to provide some funds for. We

would not be the sponsors, however. It was also stated that we would need an estimate of costs before we could consider the amount of funding.

Yearbook: Maureen Gilbert sent quotes from the printers. 48 pages with 7 color pages for \$7.00 a book. 28 pages all color is \$8.00 a book. 36 pages all color is \$9.90 a book. Denise Lang motioned to go with 48 pages for \$7.00. Linda Arnold seconded. The motion carried. Ginger Condie is working on baby pictures and quotes from 5th grade. She is also working on messages. Maureen wants to start selling the second week in May. Maureen is requesting that all yearbook sales go through the office and that Maureen be the only person to handle yearbook envelopes this year. Linda Arnold motioned and Sheri Abdullah seconded that Maureen solely handle yearbook money. Motion carried.

Brookes BBQ: It was decided that we do not have enough help to run the BBQ on budget night.

Flag Day: Tee shirts for all students will be provided by Student Council. There will be a Flag Day meeting next Thursday April 28th after school.

Field Trip Request: Mrs. Arnold is requesting \$222.00 to take pre-k on a field trip to The Discovery Center. Sheri Abdullah motioned and Denise Lang seconded that PATS sponsor this field trip. The motion carried.

Ice Cream Social: It was suggested that we sponsor an ice cream social for the kids since they did so well with the Gertrude Hawk fundraiser. This was tabled until May.

Liability Insurance: Mr. Fiorentino came to an executive session to address concerns and questions about the need for liability insurance for PATS as an outside of school organization.
