What We Are Learning

ELA: In reading we have been working on identifying fact and opinion statements. We have also started identifying fact and opinion statements within a text. In writing, we have been working on writing with specific details. We will have a **practice** state test the second week of February. This allows the students to see what the test may be like and provides us information on what skills need further instruction.

Math: We have started working on division and how it relates to multiplication. We are also continuing with multiplication. We will continue to have a practice multiplication test every week. **Please encourage them to practice their facts at home.**

Science/ Social Studies: We will continue to learn about cultures in Social Studies. In science we will start learning about measurement. This will also be worked on and assessed in math.
